also be integrated into appointments like these and enjoy world events in their city.















## 4- In addition, this competition will be a new achievement to add to the Camilo José Cela University.

# Opening of the World University Handball Championships 2024 in Antequera

Antequera, a Malaga city located in the heart of Andalusia, opens its doors to the celebration of the World University Handball Championship 2024 from June 23 to 30. Its main endorsement is the extensive experience in organizing events of great caliber and its commitment to promote and encourage everything that has to do with the union of sport and training. The competition will bring together approximately 360 athletes divided into 14 national teams, seven in the men's category and seven in the women's category.

The Fernando Argüelles Pavilion, the venue for the games, hosted this Sunday an always special and awaited opening ceremony in which the representatives of the participating countries appeared one by one; in the men's competition: Brazil, Chile, Czech Republic, France, India, Poland and Spain and in the women's competition: Chile, Czech Republic, France, India, Netherlands, Poland and Spain. Once the teams were placed on the court, it was time to give way to the institutional statements to welcome and wish good luck throughout the 7 days of the championship.

Manolo Barón, Mayor of Antequera and host, took the floor first. "It is already the second occasion that we celebrate a University Handball World Cup. Antequera has experience in organizing these tournaments and shares the spirit of university sport. We are ready to welcome all the participants and help them so that everything goes magnificently well." Next, Héctor Mauricio Escamilla, rector of Camilo José Cela University, left the following message as organizer. "We are delighted to have a world-class event and it is an opportunity to unite wills, develop the welfare of people and, especially, the cultural understanding that sport gives us".

Every championship of this type involves the International University Sports Federation, of which Rosaura Méndez is a member of the executive committee. "Antequera is a city characterized by the development of sport and we came to enjoy its tradition and heritage and this championship which, with so many delegations, is wonderful". Once the statements of the authorities were made, the dance group "Origen Crew", from the school Origen Dance Studio of Antequera, was in charge of livening up the opening ceremony before the hoisting of the FISU flag and the oath of athletes and referees, represented by Clara Gascó (player of the Spanish team) and Raúl Oyarzun (referee), to commit to show fair play and respect all the rules.





# Spain beats Poland in the first match of the World University Championship Handball (35-27)

The men's national teams of Spain (dressed in red and blue) and Poland (dressed in white), drawn in Group A, played the first match of the tournament. A duel that had an exciting start with a better staging of the Polish until, little by little, the Spanish players took the pulse of the duel and imposed their pace of play. They adjusted their defense and, being strong at the back, their offensive success increased and they took the lead on the scoreboard. At halftime, the advantage was six goals (17-11).

The team coached by Diego Dorado confirmed its good sensations after coming back from the locker room. They kept a comfortable distance on the scoreboard. They took advantage of their opponent's goalkeeper-less attack and stole several balls to score in an empty net. Before the halfway point of the second half, Poland increased their level and forced a timeout on the court when they were again six goals behind (25-19). In the final stretch, the national team, supported by the crowd, was able to bring out all its talent and was able to secure a victory (35-27) always important when starting participation in a World Championship.

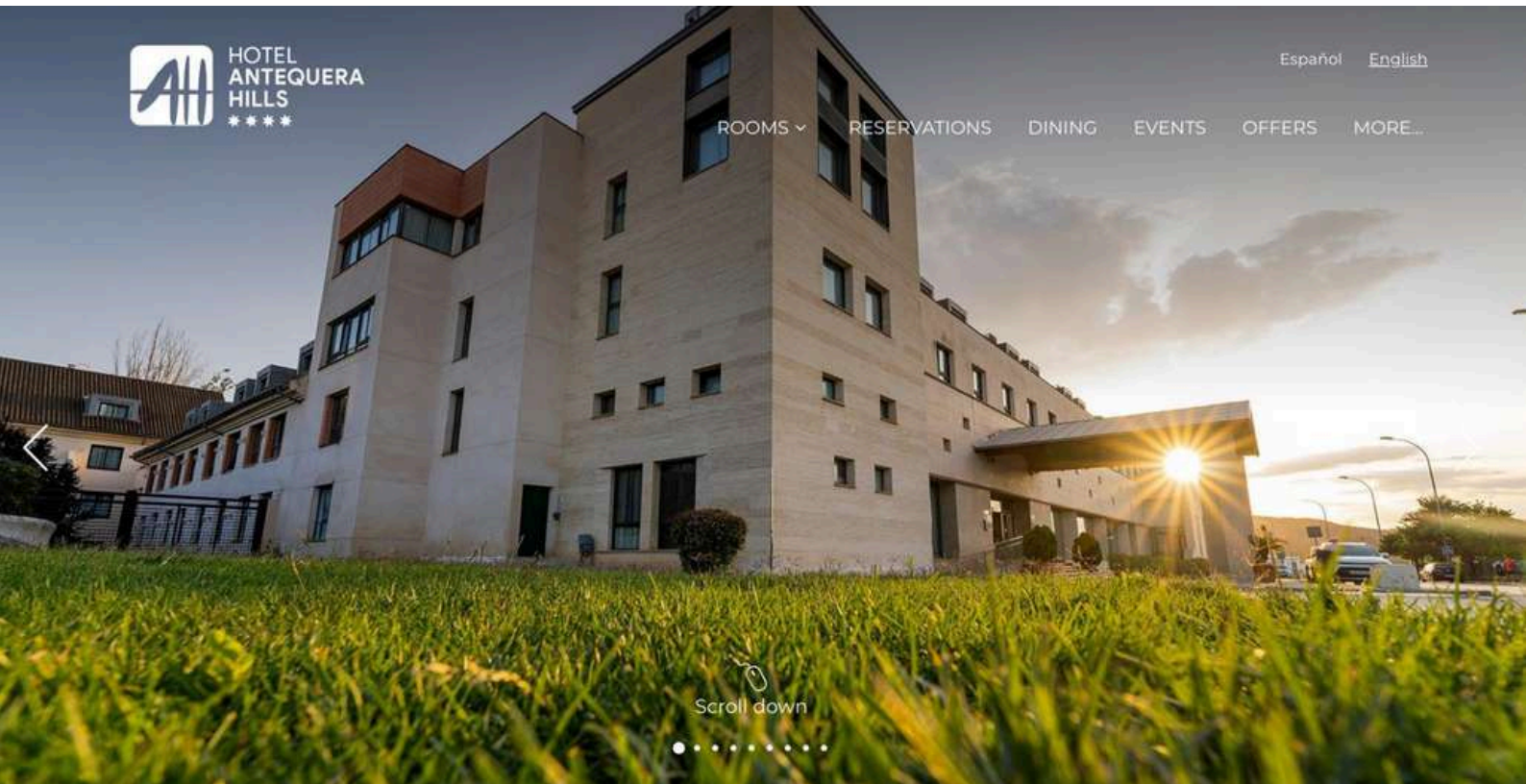
