Spain - Poland and Spain - France, the men's and women's finals of the FISU World University Championship Handball (I)

The International University Sports Federation (FISU), in its role as organiser together with the Camilo José Cela University, has decided to change the timetable for the finals of the World Championships in the Fernando Argüelles Pavilion, scheduled for Sunday 30 June, with the intention of having the best possible atmosphere in the stands and receiving the support of the fans of this sport in the City of Los Dólmenes and nearby municipalities. The women's match will take place between Spain and France, starting at 10:00 and the men's match, between Spain and Poland, at 13:00. This will be followed by the medal ceremonies and the closing ceremony.

Spain knocks France out of the final and Poland wins a tight match against Czech Republic

The University Warriors have not lost their upward momentum in the tournament and have reached the final without losing a game and, moreover, giving the impression of a very solid defensive team that knows how to suffer and impose its individual talent when it comes to sending the ball into the back of the net. The players, coached by Diego Dorado, were very consistent from start to finish, knowing the difficulty of the match against a physical and intense opponent like France. A constant exchange of blows on the court until, in the second half, Spain stepped on the accelerator and broke the scoreboard to close a favourable score of 33-27.

In the other men's semi-final, the excitement and tension to find out the winner was maintained until the end of the match. Poland had a tough clash with the Czech Republic. Two teams that competed at a good level in the group phase to opt for the prize of advancing to the previous step to fight for the coveted gold medal. The score was very close and, as the minutes ticked by, neither side wanted to slip up, but the Poles proved more reliable than the Czechs and edged an evenly matched contest in their favour. The advantage was just one goal (30-29). Czech Republic and France will meet for the bronze medal.

France beat Poland to confirm their place in the final and Spain do the same against the Czech Republic.

The University Warriors, meanwhile, faced a more straightforward match to reach the final. An almost perfect performance to quickly knock out the Czech Republic. A very solid defence to concede very few goals and an excellent performance by the two goalkeepers when they were on the court. In attack, collective play prevailed. Good shots from beyond 9 metres, connections with the pivot position and passes to the wingers to increase the lead to 13 goals: 27-14.

In the first semi-final, played in the Argüelles at 18:15, France entered the game with more pace and their opponents, Poland, found it difficult to counteract and soon found themselves with a disadvantage of several goals. It was not easy to reduce the deficit and they tried their best, but came up against a formidable French defence and a fast and accurate attack. Nothing changed in the second half, so all the French side had to do was to confirm a big lead to be in the most important match. Poland, on the other hand, will play for bronze and not finish fourth against the Czech Republic.

The battle for fifth, sixth and seventh place gets under way

On the sidelines of the day's top matches in the competition, six teams kicked off a triangular battle to determine which country would place fifth, sixth and seventh in both the men's and women's categories. Brazil's boys took on Chile's boys and edged them by a narrow 20-16 scoreline, while the Netherlands' natural-born players thrashed India's girls 52-23. Throughout the weekend, between the Pabellón Fernando Argüelles and the Agustín Rodríguez, all these matches will be played between those who could not place at the top in the group phase.






