1- A successful handball championship is coming to an end. As a spectator, not as an organiser, how did you see it?

It was a very nice championship, with 4 teams almost at the same level, and good matches. The court was amazing and the presence of the fans made the party even more beautiful. The atmosphere created during the matches was quite good and the most beautiful thing was that apart from the rivalry during the championship there was friendship off the pitch.

2- As part of the organisation, what difficulties have you had to overcome?

There are always many details that most people don't know about, but I think the main difficulty was about how to adjust the schedule so that all the matches could be played at the Argüelles. An effort to start the matches very early and always finish late. And with this you have to adjust also the operating hours of the restaurant. Another issue was the cleaning of the court, so that the next day it would always be spotless and clean for the next round. And all this thinking about the best for the athletes and their experiences at the University Handball World Cup.

3- In this type of championships the rivalry between teams stands out, but also the friendship and coexistence of all of them, what have your feelings been?

We have really seen a lot of rivalry but also a lot of friendship, and I think that a big part of it is due to the fact that all the delegations were accommodated in one hotel, with a lot of quality, which had a big common area and a swimming pool. I found it interesting to see that even different delegations have come together to support another team and I think it is a good sign of the atmosphere that was found.

4- What do you think are the attractions of handball as a growing sport?

Handball is a very intense and dynamic sport. In addition to the intensity and the matches, there is a lot of respect between athletes.

The countdown begins to find out who the winners of the Antequera 2024 World University Handball Championship will be. In an exciting day, this Saturday, in the men's category, France beat the Czech Republic with 32 goals against 29 of his opponent, being, therefore, in third place in the championship, in its category. For their part, the Polish girls defeated the Czechs (22-18) to take bronze in the competition.

The International University Sports Federation (FISU), in its role as organiser together with the Camilo José Cela University, has decided to change the timetable for the finals of the World University Handball Championship in the Fernando Argüelles Pavilion in Antequera, scheduled for Sunday 30 June, with the intention of having the best possible atmosphere in the stands and receiving the support of the lovers of this sport in the City of Los Dólmenes and nearby municipalities. The women's match will take place between Spain and France, starting at 10:00 and the men's match, between Spain and Poland, at 13:00. This will be followed by the medal ceremonies and the closing ceremony.

The competition, which is celebrating its twenty-sixth edition, brings together 14 international teams, both in the men's and women's categories, once again making Antequera the epicentre of university sport.

For this, the collaboration between the different administrations, sports federations, private entities and educational centres, whose joint efforts are making it possible to hold this World University Championship in Antequera, has been essential.

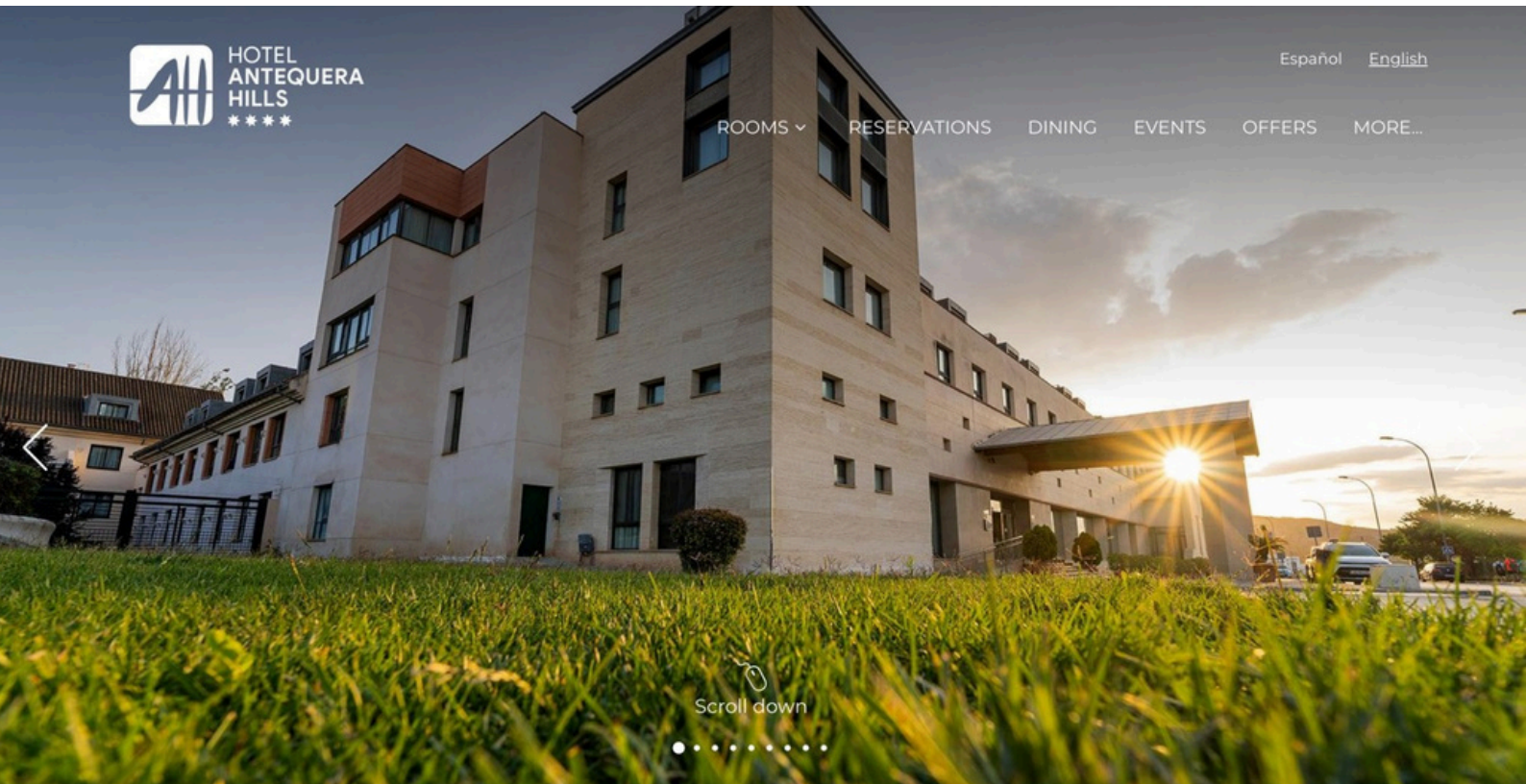

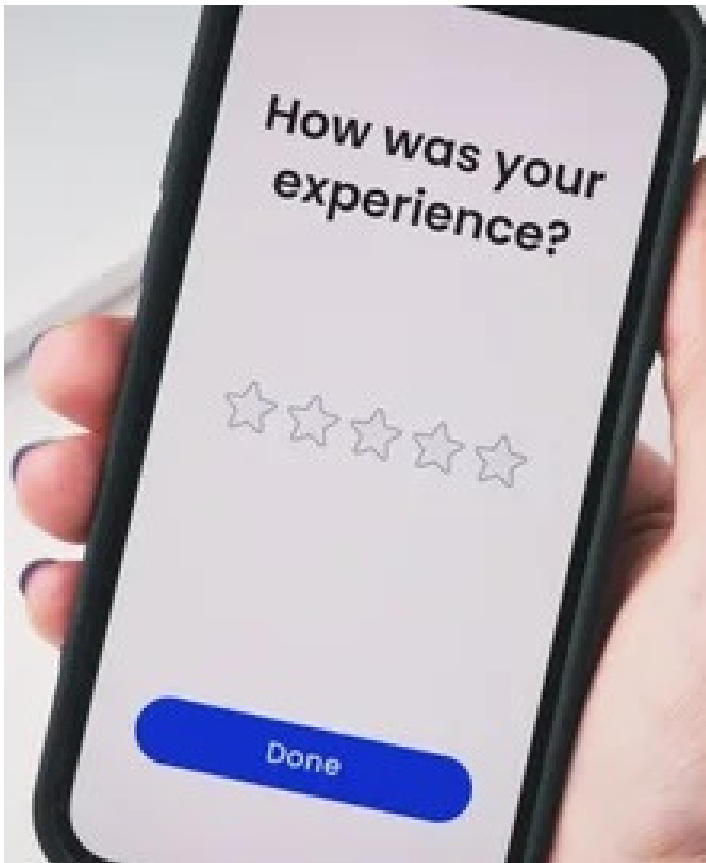
