LAST REMINDERS

We kindly ask all participants who have not yet done so to complete their Individual Entry Forms through the GMS registration platform. This is required to ensure that your accreditation is ready upon your arrival in Östersund.

Please ensure that the full participation fee is paid with the invoice due no later than August 14, as cash payment is not accepted.

If you require a visa invitation letter, we kindly ask you to submit your Individual Entry Form and complete the payment process as soon as possible.

Should you wish to prepare a poster, do not forget to make it informative and engaging, highlighting best practices, new projects, initiatives, and/or achievements. Posters should be submitted in A1, PDF format (portrait or landscape) to education@fisunet and healthy.campus@fisunet by 7 August. Posters submitted after this deadline will need to be printed by the submitting institution/NUSF/CUSF.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Bring a warm jumper or sweater, as well as a windproof and waterproof jacket. August weather in Östersund can be sunny and warm, but also cold, windy, and rainy.
- There is no formal dress code; casual clothing is recommended.
- Bring suitable sportswear and footwear.
- FISU World Forum Fair: Bring promotional items representing your country, your NUSF/CUSF or university to display at the FISU World Forum Fair. Flags, cultural items, brochures, small giveaways, and samples of local food or beverages (alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited) are welcome to help showcase your culture and traditions. Should you wish to do a max. 5-minutes cultural performance on stage, please address your request to fisuforum2026@miun.se
- Bring badges and/or pins to exchange with fellow participants.
