Accommodation and catering.



Thanks to our partner the **CROUS**, all catering and accommodation facilities will be easily accessible and located less than 2 km from the Championship Village. Delegations and participants will enjoy menus specially designed to meet athletic needs, combining balance and energy throughout the competition.

The CROUS will also provide welcoming and convivial spaces, ideal for relaxation, and sharing, helping to strengthen team spirit and enhance the collective experience surrounding the event.

Transport

As part of its eco-friendly approach, the Organizing Committee has chosen to place sustainable mobility at the core of the event.

All official travel — *excluding airport and luggage transfers, and match days for the competing teams* — will be carried out using the Bordeaux Métropole public transportation network, renowned for its quality, reliability, and extensive coverage across the Bordeaux metropolitan area.

The TBM network offers modern trams, frequent bus lines, and self-service bicycles, making it easy to reach the competition venues, accommodations, and key areas of the university campus.

This transportation solution—practical, ecological, and user-friendly—perfectly reflects the Organizing Committee's commitment to reducing the event's carbon footprint while promoting soft and collective mobility.

Financial

Participation fees

The competing countries, upon arrival, shall pay their dues for ***participation fees 80 EUR*** per night and per person to the Organising Committee.

Travel costs

The countries shall be responsible for their own cost of travel to the nearest official point of entry of the Championship and return. The designated entry points are the Bordeaux-Mérignac Airport and the Saint-Jean train station.

Events will take place at the **SMART Performance and Technology** Center in Pessac, University of Bordeaux — a 4,200 m² state-of-the-art **connected sports facility** inaugurated in 2024.

Dedicated to **research, innovation, and athletic performance**, SMART features advanced technologies such as motion and muscle sensors, GPS tracking, and robotic cameras. It brings together athletes, researchers, and professionals to enhance performance and foster collaboration between sport, science, and technology.

Bellegrave

The handball court at the Bellegrave sports hall in Pessac is part of the Bellegrave Sports Complex located on Avenue du Colonel Jacqui. It is a high-quality facility featuring a nearly new wooden floor and modern equipment. The hall offers excellent access and free unlimited parking nearby.

It hosts **matches** and **training sessions** for the **local handball club**, Stade Pessacais Union Club Handball (SPUC), which also runs health and community sports activities. The facility is well suited for handball competitions with a lively and sportive atmosphere, welcoming women's, men's, and youth teams.
