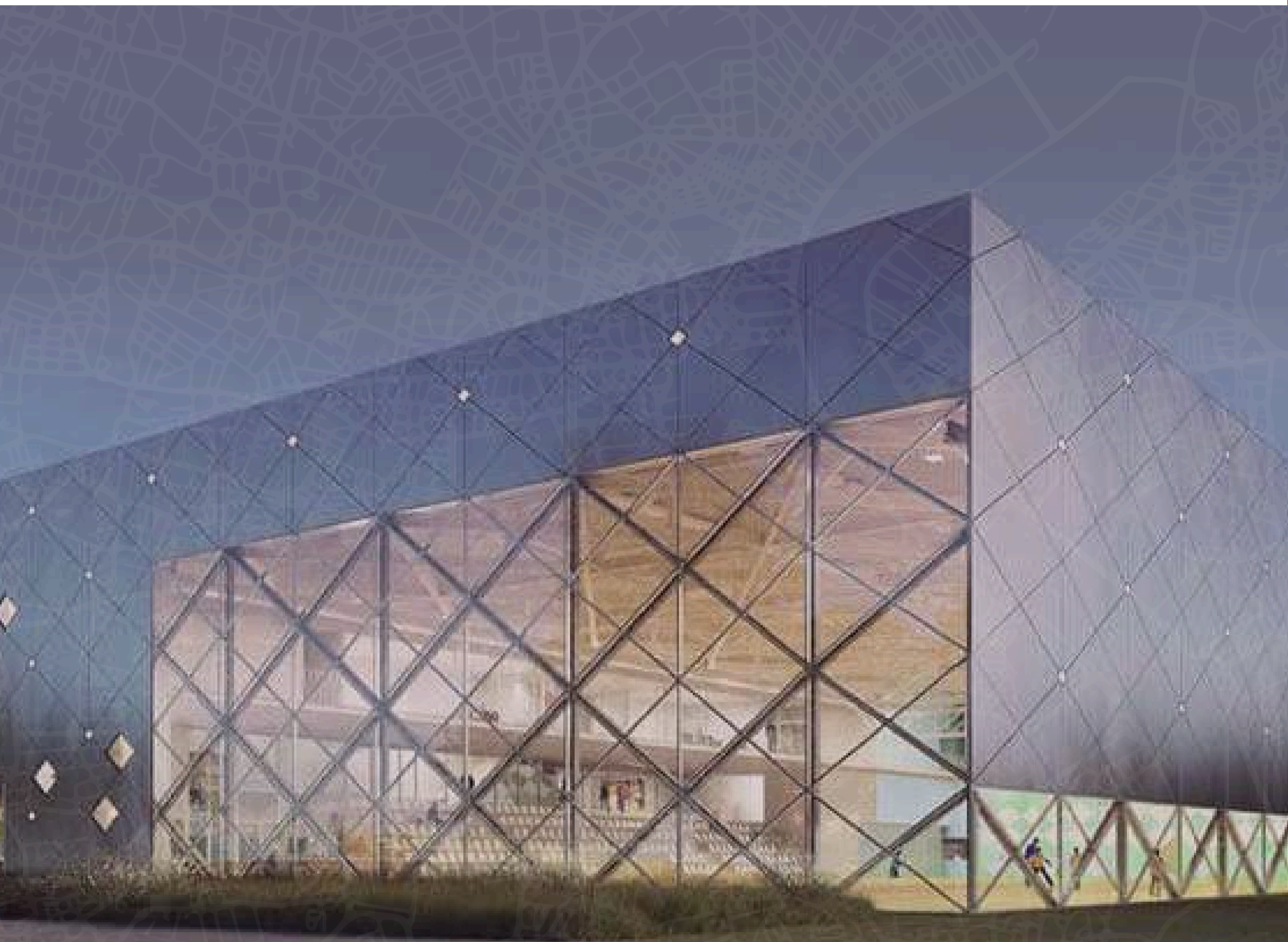

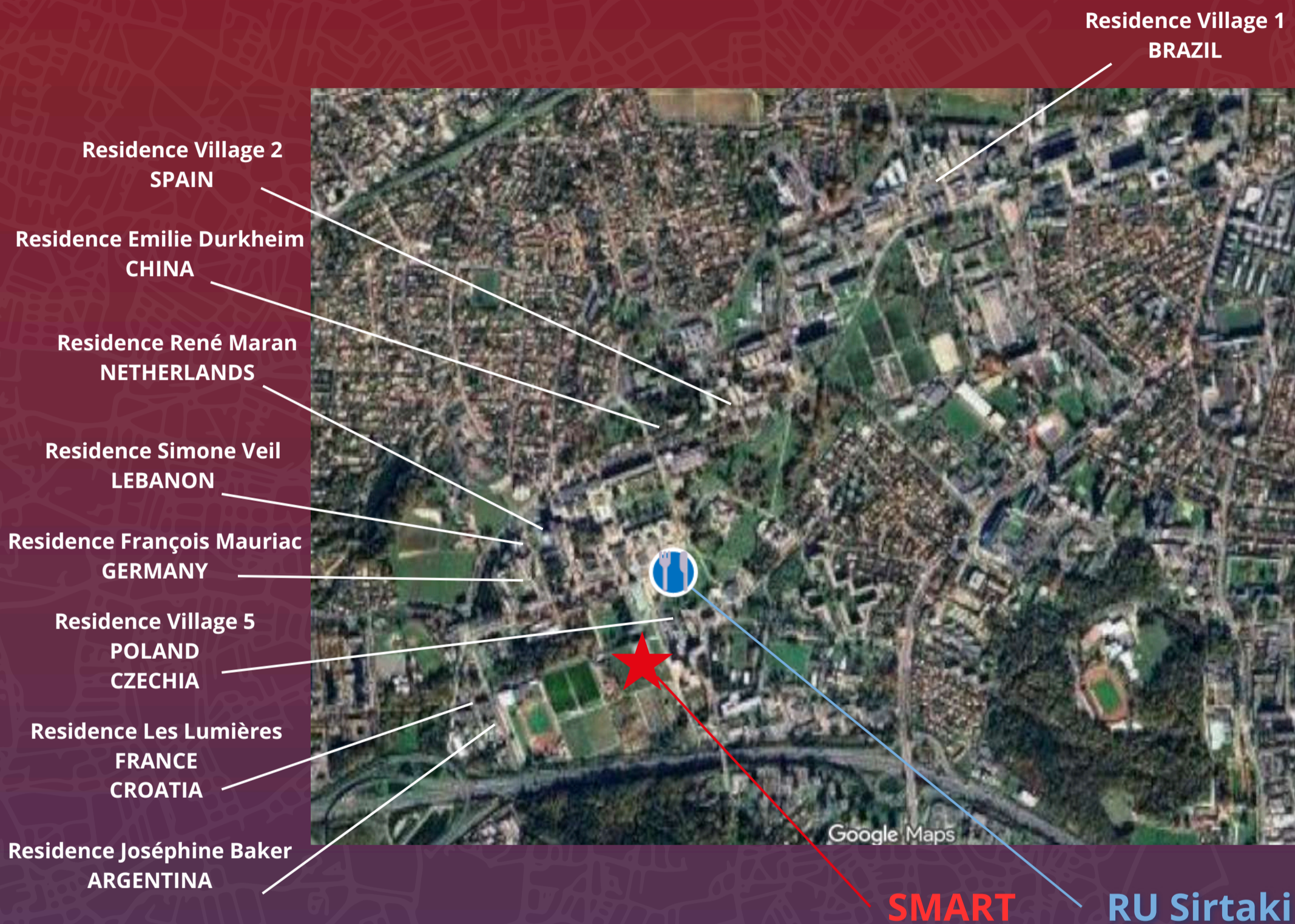

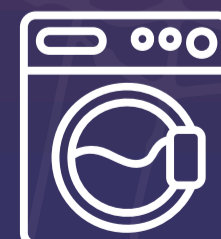

GENERAL INFORMATION



PADLET

The medical service for the World Handball Championship is designed to ensure the safety and well-being of all participants throughout the competition.



Each competition venue is equipped with a dedicated on-site doctor, supported by trained medical staff ready to respond quickly to any injury or emergency situation. A coordinated medical system is in place to provide efficient and immediate care.

A dedicated medical shuttle is available to transport injured participants to appropriate healthcare facilities when needed. A coordinating physician oversees all medical decisions and ensures proper orientation to partner hospitals and clinics, including the Clinique Mutualiste de Pessac, the Clinique du Sport de Mérignac, the Bordeaux University Hospital (CHU de Bordeaux), and the medical service of the CREPS of Bordeaux.

Each delegation will be welcomed at the airport or train station according to their travel plan. Upon arrival, they will receive their transportation schedule for the entire stay, including transfers between accommodation, training, and competition venues.

A TBM Congress Pass valid on the entire Bordeaux Metropolitan public transport network will be provided with each accreditation. It is valid for 11 days — please keep it safe, as no replacement pass will be issued.

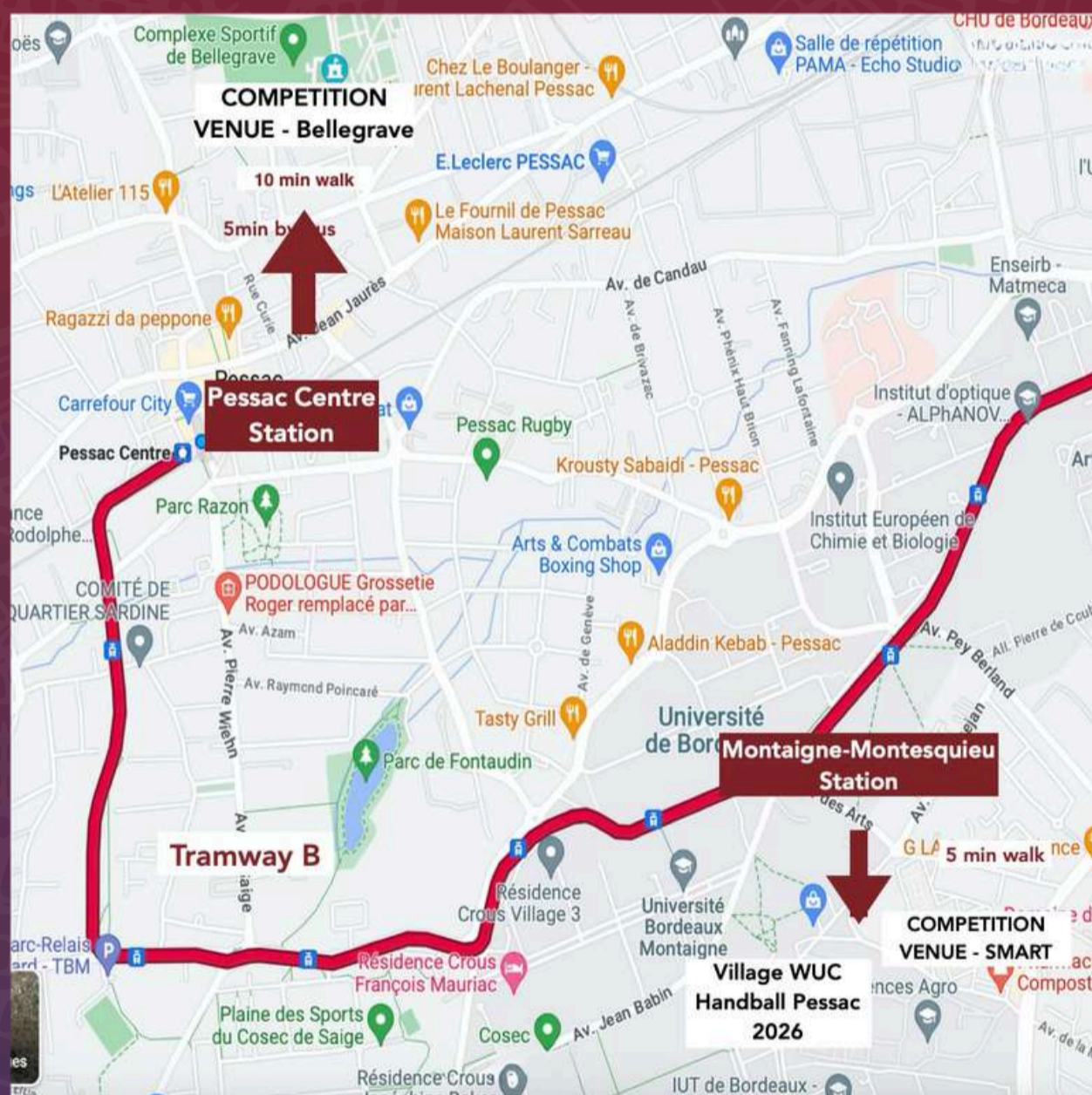

Acting as the central hub of the Championship, SMART benefits from its ideal location near participants' accommodations and various dining options.

VENUES



The SMART building of the University of Bordeaux will serve as one of the official competition venues, hosting the official training sessions starting on June 18, 2026. On June 20, it will also be the stage for the Opening Ceremony, surrounded by a lively animation village offering activities and entertainment for all participants and visitors.

The SMART (Sports Management, Advanced Research and Technologies) building is a modern sports facility located on the campus. It combines high-level sports infrastructures with spaces dedicated to research, innovation, and education in sport sciences, making it a key hub for both athletic performance and academic excellence.

The Bellegrave Sports Hall, located in the city of Pessac, will serve as the second official competition venue of the Championship. It will host the final stages of the tournament, as well as the Closing Ceremony and the Gala event.

With a capacity of nearly 1,200 seated spectators, Bellegrave is also home to the emblematic SPUC Handball Club, a key player in the local sports community.

Shuttle transfers will be organized for delegations to and from the main village, ensuring smooth and convenient transportation throughout the event.

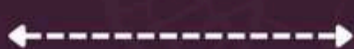

SPORT REGULATIONS

The Handball tournaments shall be organised following the most recent Technical Regulations of the International Handball Federation (IHF). In case of dispute in the interpretation of the rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative

1. Match point system

Teams will compete against one another in each group on a round-robin basis. Match points will be awarded for each group match according to the following criteria :

- Win = 2 points
- Draw = 1 point
- Loss = 0 point

No extra time shall be played during the group phase

2. Classification criteria

The ranking of each team in each group will be determined as follows :

- Higher number of points obtained in all group matches
- Goal difference across all group matches
- Higher number of goals scored in all group matches
- Goal ratio - the number of goals scored divided by the number of goals conceded

If two or more teams are equal on the basis of the above four criteria, their rankings will be determined as follows :

- Higher number of points obtained in the group matches between the teams involved
- Goal difference derived from the group matches contested between the teams involved
- Higher number of goals scored in all group matches between the teams involved
- A draw conducted by the local organizing committee, in the presence of the team captains

This is a full ranking tournament, meaning that teams will compete for every position in the final standings

3. Delegations composition

Each country is allowed to enter a maximum of 16 athletes per tournament and per game.

4. Final stages

The placement matches (5-8), quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals shall be played in a knockout system.

For these matches : the placement matches (5-8), quarter-finals and semi-finals, in case of a draw at the end of the regular playing time, a direct 7-metre shoot-out shall be used to determine a winner in accordance with Rule 2:2 of the Rules of the Game (IHF).

For the finals (medal matches), overtime is played following a 5-minute break, if a match is tied at the end of the regular playing time. The overtime period consists of two (2) halves of five (5) minutes, with a 1-minute half-time break.

If the match is again tied after the first overtime period, a second period is played after a 5-minute break. This overtime period also consists of two (2) halves of five (5) minutes, with a 1-minute half-time break. Should the match still not be decided after the second overtime period, the winner is determined through a 7 m shoot-out in accordance with Rule 2:2 of the Rules of the Game (IHF).

PROCEDURE

First step :
