4. OFFICIAL ENTRY POINT TRANSPORTATION

A) ENTRY POINT

Chopin Airport (IATA: WAW, ICAO: EPWA) is the largest airport in Poland, located about 8 km southwest of the city center. It serves domestic, international, charter, and cargo flights. The airport has two runways and a modern passenger terminal, ensuring a comfortable travel experience. The organizing committee provides transportation from the airport to the hotel on the official arrival and departure days.



B) TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide dedicated transportation for the exclusive use of event participants.

The cars/buses will operate on the following routes:

- To/from Chopin Airport for arrivals and departures.
- To/from sports venues for competitions.
- To/from official ceremonies.
- For VIPs, delegates, guests, and referees as needed.

The organizing committee provides free public transport upon presentation of the championship badge and an identity document.

5. REGISTRATION

POLAND VISA

To participate in the World University Championship Futsal 2026 Warsaw, each delegation must comply with the entry regulations of the host country, Poland.

Who Needs a Visa?

Visa requirements vary depending on the nationality of the applicant. Invitation Letters

To support visa applications, the Organizing Committee will issue official invitation letters to registered participants. To obtain these letters:

Submit the required passport information and personal details of your delegation members by deadline set by the OC, usually at least 60 days before the event).

Participation fees

The competing countries, upon arrival, shall pay their dues for participation fees 80 EUR per night and per person to the Organising Committee



6. ACCOMODATION CATERING

A) ACCOMODATION

Competitors and team officials will be accommodated at the Arche Hotel (Krakowska and Geologiczna) – 4-star hotels located close to the airport and sport venues. They will have for their disposal twin bed rooms up to 23 m². Towels will be exchanged at least 2 times during the Championship and always on request.

The hotel is equipped in office working spaces and a spacious meeting room which will be rented for the sole use of WUC accredited people during the Championship. In the Hotel there will be access to free wi-fi Internet, laundry machines. There are many shops near the Hotel. FISU Officials will be accommodated at a high standard hotel - Hotel Golden Tulip.

Single room extra fee: 50 euros/night/person
Extra official fee: 140 euros/night

Check-in: 2:00 PM
Check-out: 11:00 AM.

If you plan to arrive earlier on the day of arrival, the following rules apply:
Check-in before 10:00 AM is 100% of the per-night rate per person.
Check-in between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM is 50% of the per-night rate per person.

If you plan to extend your stay on the day of departure, the following rules apply:
Extensions until 3:00 PM: 50% of the per-night rate per person.
Extensions longer than 4 hours (after 3:00 PM): 100% of the per-night rate per person.



B) CATERING

Competitors and team officials will be catered at the restaurant in the Arche Hotel. Menu will be composted considering various diets and allergies. Access to drinking water will be unlimited for all accredited people. Hotel has a great experience in serving appropriate number of people.

The Officials (VIPs, FISU delegates and representatives, ISF and NSF representatives, referees, technical staff etc.) will have at their disposal the hotel restaurant at the place of Accommodation.

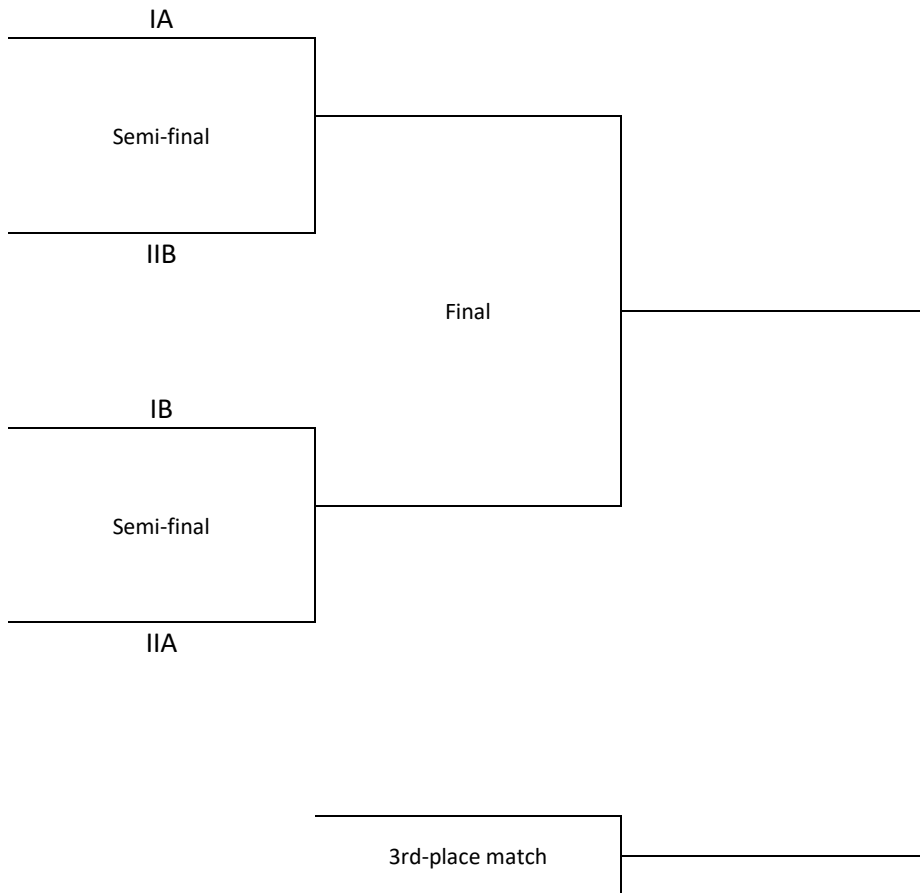

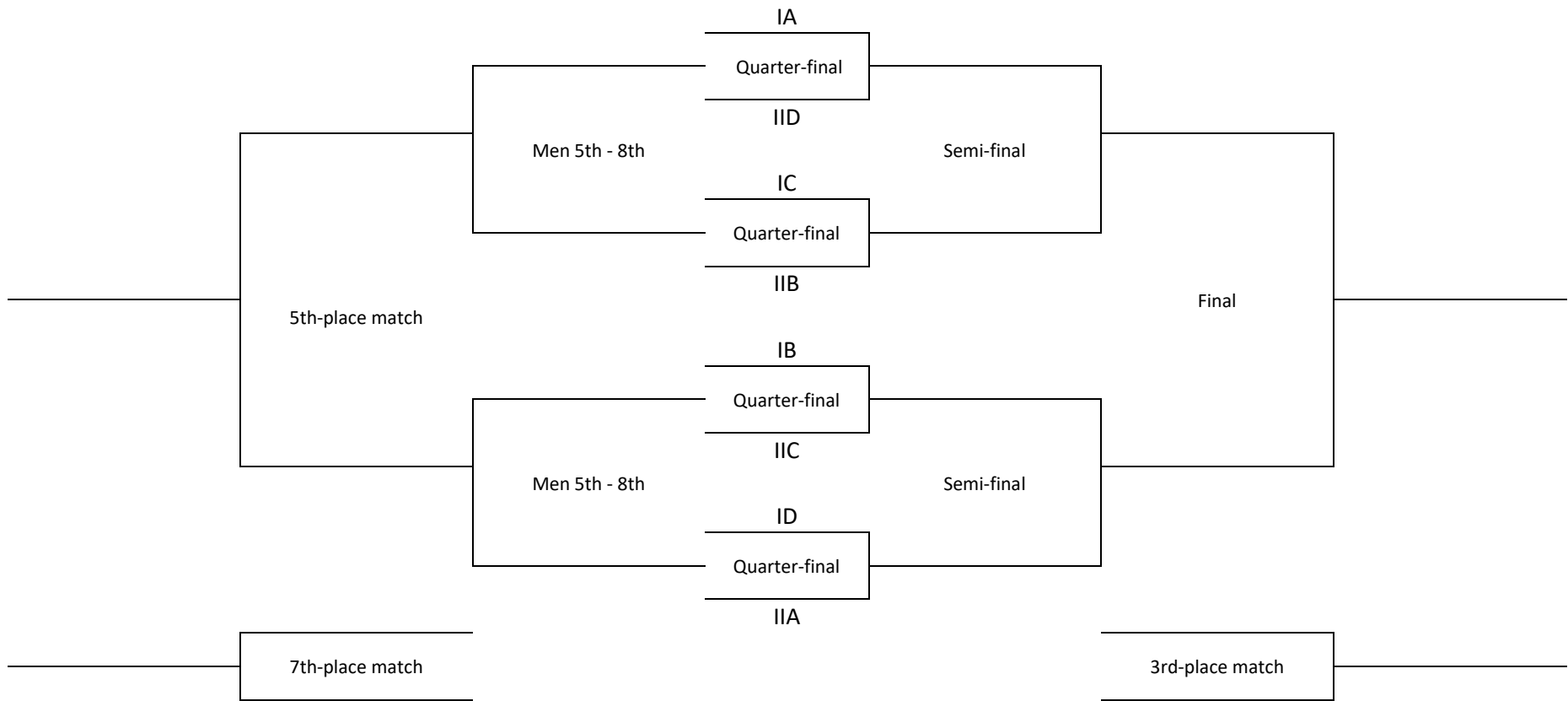

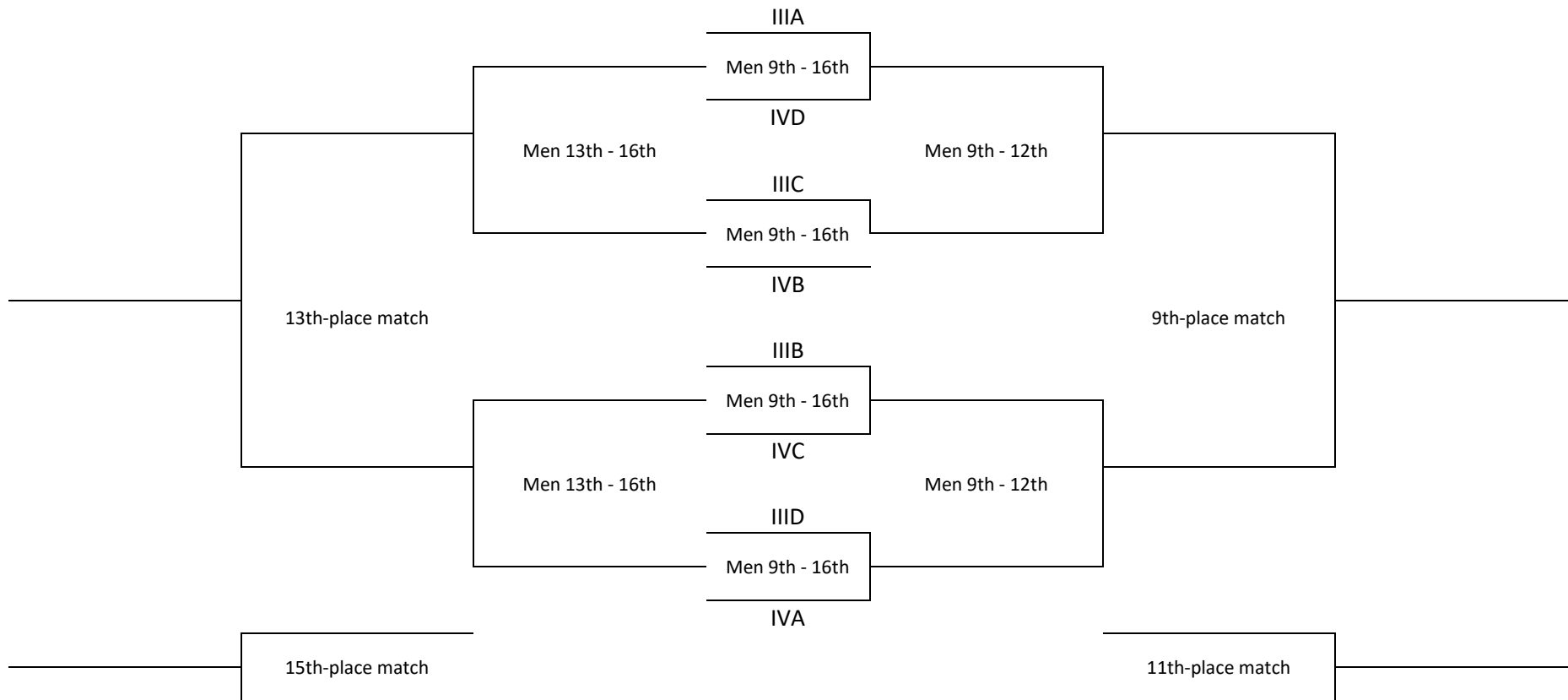

11. TICKETS

Tickets for all matches of the World University Futsal Championship – Warsaw 2026 are available online via the eBilet platform at:

Tickets are sold by match sessions, each covering min. 2 matches. Each day features a morning and an afternoon session. Ticket prices start from PLN 22.90 for group stage sessions, with higher prices applicable for knockout stage matches, semi-finals, and finals.

All accredited tournament participants are granted free admission to all matches at all venues. Accredited participants will enter the venues through separate, dedicated entrances. A designated spectator zone will also be reserved exclusively for accredited participants at each competition hall.
