3. VISIT TO THE UNIVERSITY RECTORATE

Each delegation is invited to attend the official reception at the University Rectorate with a maximum of **two representatives**, preferably members of the delegation's officers.

Volunteers will accompany participants from **Alfil Residence** to the metro station and throughout the journey to the Rectorate, promoting the use of **public and sustainable transport**. The total travel time is approximately **30 minutes** (metro and walking).



Departure from Alfil Residence: 19:00. Please be punctual to ensure the group arrives on time for the reception.

Delegations taking part in the **guided visit to the Alcazaba** should proceed **directly to the Rectorate** after the tour, without returning to the residence beforehand.

4. INCLUSIVE DRAW TOURNAMENT

The 1st Inclusive Draw Tournament is one of the most inspiring activities of the FISU World University Championship Padel. Organised in collaboration with **Palas para Todos Association**, the initiative highlights the power of sport to promote inclusion, respect, and equal opportunities.

University athletes join players with intellectual disabilities on court, sharing matches, experiences, and unforgettable moments through the special "Champions" category. More than a competition, the activity creates meaningful connections, allowing participants to discover the enthusiasm, determination, and passion that every player brings to the game.

The Inclusive Draw Tournament reflects the core values of university sport—friendship, solidarity, and inclusion—while sending a clear message that padel has no barriers. The initiative invites university athletes to become part of a unique experience where competition and inclusion go hand in hand.



5. RESEARCH: CHAMPIONSHIP EVALUATION

During this championship, a study will be carried out into the organisation and running of the sporting event. The aim of this study is to examine perceived quality, value, satisfaction levels, the image of the event and the destination, sustainable practices and the impact of hosting this sporting event, with a view to improving the organisation and sustainability of future events of this kind.

As part of the research, we are asking participants to voluntarily complete a questionnaire based on their profile (athlete, coach, delegation leaders, volunteers, officials, organisers, spectators, etc.), so we would ask that athletes, coaches and delegation leaders alike complete it and share their views with us. The questionnaire is anonymous and takes just a few minutes to complete.
